What do matching colors on the card indicate?



Answer

You need 14 tiles to declare Mahjong!



Answer

Colors show which Suits and Dragons you need. They also help match combinations that belong together.



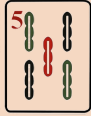
Answer

Matching tiles are identical tiles from the same Suit and number, the same Dragon, Wind, or Flower.



Answer

They mean you need matching Suits or Dragons. If the colors are the same, the Suit and Dragon should match too.

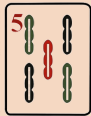

What does “Like Numbers“ mean?



Answer

It means you need the same numbers or Dragons, but in different Suits.



Answer

It's the Dragon that matches a third, unused Suit.



Answer

E means East, and F means Flower.



Answer

Like Numbers are identical numbers used throughout the hand.

In the **Consecutive Run Section**, what do numbers like 1s, 2s, 3s, 4s, and 5s mean?



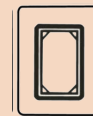

What does “Pung 7s Only” mean?

Question

What do X and C stand for on the card?



Answer

They represent ascending consecutive numbers. You can use any sequence of consecutive numbers, not just 1-5.



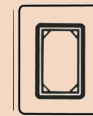
Answer

You must use a set of three matching 7s, and only 7s.



Answer

You can choose one of those numbers (1, 3, or 5) to make a Kong.



Answer

X means **Exposed**—you can call a tile from another player to complete a Pung, Kong, Quint, or Sextet. **C** means **Concealed**—you must build the hand privately, only able to call the last tile for Mahjong.

Can Jokers be used in the Singles and Pairs Section or NEWS? Why not?

What tiles are needed for NEWS?

If a hand is printed in Green and Red, do you have to use Bams and Craks in that order?



Question

In which Sections can you choose numbers to build your hand?



Answer

Nope! Singles and Pairs don't allow Jokers since they need specific, non-replaceable tiles. NEWS is made of four Single tiles, so no Jokers there either.



Answer

You need one of each Wind:
North,
East,
West,
and South.



Answer

Not at all! You get to choose which Suits to use and in what order.



Answer

You get some flexibility in Consecutive Run, Like Numbers, certain hands in Quints, and some Singles and Pairs hands.
